

RECOGNITION OF QUALIFICATIONS – APPOINTED BUILDING EXPERT

1. NOTIFICATION

Persons who intend to work on a temporarily or occasionally basis in Denmark as an appointed building expert, on basis of their professional qualifications acquired in another EU or EEA country or countries with which the EU has entered into an agreement on access to pursue a regulated profession, are required to report to the Danish Safety Technology Authority before carrying out the profession for the first time.

Persons who intend to work on a permanent basis in Denmark as an appointed building expert on basis of their professional qualifications acquired in another EU or EEA country or countries with which the EU has entered into an agreement on access to pursue a regulated profession, have to use this form to request for recognition of their professional qualifications.

5. REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION TO BE PROVIDED WITH THE NOTIFICATION

Temporary or occasional pursuit

- Insurance agreement or other forms of personal or collective protection in connection with professional liability.
- Documentation for your nationality.
- The certification from the home country that provides that you are operating legally in the home country and that you have not been forbidden to exercise business as an appointed building expert.
- Documentation for occupational skills and documentation that you have been operating as an appointed building expert for a minimum period of 1 year within the past 10 years.

Establishing a business

- Documentation of nationality
- Copies of your certificates of professional competence or of the evidence of formal qualifications giving access to pursue the profession as an appointed building expert, or other relevant attestations of professional competence and evidence of formal qualifications.
- Documentation of any professional experience as an appointed building expert, or equivalent profession for at least one year on a full-time basis or equivalent duration on a part-time basis during the ten years prior to the application in EU-countries where the profession or the education and training leading to the profession is not regulated
- Documentation certifying that you are not prevented from practicing your profession as an appointed building expert, or equivalent profession in your home country or the country from which you come, even temporarily.
- And documentation certifying that you are of legal age, are not under guardianship and manage your own affairs.
